Competition formula:

- In all categories, according to the KNAS regulations The competition formula will be: 1 poule (or a poule unique) and eliminations without repechage. In addition there will be a secondary competition for who loses in the 1st elimination round.
- A "second-chance-play-off" is organized for category adults who would like to continue to fence after losing the first round of eliminations. Male female mixed. All who opt for this, must re-register for participation in case of a defeat in the first elimination round, free of charge.
- Youth categories U10, U12 and U14 fence out (a later TBD number of) places after losing on the tableau.
- The DT reserves the right to adjust the competition formula if it deems it necessary.

Material: According to KNAS regulations.

Trophies: Women and men separately. There are medals and certificates for 1st, 2nd and 2 semi-finalists. Also trophies or medals for best 3 in the "second-chance-play-off", women and men mixed.

Registration: Participation is possible for fencers with a KNAS license or licenses from a foreign fencing association. Participants from the Netherlands and Belgium can register via www.nahouw.net

Closing date: Registration is possible until 19 May 2027

Payment: For members of the KNAS, participation via www.nahouw.net costs €27,- . Payment by members of foreign fencing federations can be made in cash, with QR on arrival at the tournament location and costs €27,-. Cash payment on location by KNAS members costs €30.

Referees: The organization will ask and invite referees itself. Referees are offered lunch and €45 daily allowance for judging during a full tournament.

Equipment sales/repair: There will be a competition service available.
